<b>June 20, 2018</b>	Application packet posted on Indiana Bar Foundation website ( <a href="http://www.inbf.org">www.inbf.org</a> ). Nomination materials include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Application Instructions</li><li>• Application</li><li>• Summary of Rules</li><li>• Timeline of Program</li></ul>
<b>September 28, 2018</b>	Deadline for submission of postmarked nomination materials to Collin Gruver, Director of Civic Education Programs, Indiana Bar Foundation. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nomination form bearing school principal's signature</li><li>• 350 to 500-word (typed) student essay written by the student</li><li>• Student resume</li><li>• Letter of support from principal</li></ul>
<b>Early-October, 2018</b>	Evaluation of nominations and selection of ten finalists by Indiana Bar Foundation, Indiana Department of Education, and Indiana Association of School Principals selection teams.
<b>October 19, 2018</b>	Notification of ten finalists by phone call, email, or letter to principal and student.
<b>October 27, 2018</b>	Written test and individual interview at Indiana Bar Foundation, Indianapolis. <b><i>Exam and interviews will only happen on this date.</i></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 9:30am – 12:00pm: Written exam</li><li>• 12:00pm – 1:00pm: Lunch and free time</li><li>• 1:00pm – 4:00pm: Individual interviews with judges</li></ul>
<b>December 1, 2018</b>	Names of two Delegates and first and second Alternates sent to Hearst Foundation. Delegates and Alternates will not be notified until selectees' packets of information have been verified by Hearst Foundation and the Indiana Bar Foundation is given permission to notify the public.
<b>Mid-December, 2018</b>	Delegates and Alternates notified by Hearst Foundation and Indiana Bar Foundation
<b>March 2 – 9, 2019</b>	United States Senate Youth Program Washington Week in Washington, D.C.
