October 18, 2019	Notification of ten finalists by phone call, email, or letter to principal and student.
October 26, 2019	Written test and individual interview at Indiana Bar Foundation, Indianapolis. <i>Exam and interviews will only happen on this date.</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 9:30am – 12:00pm: Written exam• 12:00pm – 1:00pm: Lunch and free time• 1:00pm – 4:00pm: Individual interviews with judges
