Mock Trial Volunteer Opportunities



The Foundation is looking for both attorneys and non-attorneys to serve as judges at upcoming mock trial competitions. Morning, afternoon, and evening shifts are available at multiple locations around the state:

- February 8 - Evansville
- February 15 - Hammond & Indianapolis
- February 22 - South Bend
- March 7-8 - State Competition (Indianapolis)

U.S. Senate Youth Delegates Announced

Eilidh MacLeod, a junior at Signature School in Evansville, and Aldo Medina, a senior at Arsenal Technical High School in Indianapolis, will represent Indiana at the 2020 U.S. Senate Youth Program's Washington Week and will each receive a \$10,000 college scholarship for undergraduate study.

This year, 61 young Hoosiers applied for this competitive, merit-based program. The top ten applicants selected then took an exam on government, public affairs and history, wrote an essay and conducted an interview with state judges and attorneys. The Bar Foundation administers the application process with funds provided by The Hearst

For 2020, Indiana has passed a Traffic Amnesty Program which is in effect from January 1 - December 31. People in Indiana now have new help getting their driver's license back after having it suspended. They can get their fines and fees cut down so their licenses can be reinstated.
